



#### ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CLUB ANNUAL REPORT 2019-20

The Entrepreneurship Development Club (ED Club) at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College is committed to cultivating entrepreneurial skills and innovation among students. It provides a platform for students to explore business ideas, develop practical skills, and transform creative concepts into viable ventures. During the academic year 2019-2020, the ED Club organized a variety of events aimed at promoting creativity and business acumen. The year kicked off with an inauguration on January 3, 2020, where Principal Prof. Abdul Azeez emphasized the importance of innovation and risk-taking in entrepreneurship. This was followed by "Esperanza'20," an exhibition on January 19, 2020, where students showcased their talents in art, craft, and culinary creations, promoting entrepreneurial thinking. 

4. Innovation and Entrepreneurship






6. <u>Workshop and Skill Development Training Programme in</u> <u>Soap, Lotion, and Detergent Making</u>
