

FOUR YEAR UG PROGRAMS

Starting in the 2025-26 academic year, Kottakkal Farook Arts & Science College, in line with the University of Calicut, has launched four-year undergraduate programs under NEP 2020. This initiative aims to enhance academic flexibility and curriculum enrichment. Students can choose from various minor courses in addition to their major discipline, offering a more comprehensive educational experience.

FYUGP Structure

Course Structure

Students will have three options to complete their degree:

1. 3-year UG Degree: Students can exit after three years with a regular degree.
2. 4-year UG Degree (Honours): Students who pass all courses can continue into the fourth year. Upon completing the Honours degree, they can pursue a one-year PG program.
3. 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research): Students who secure 75% or above in their three-year degree can engage in research under a qualified guide and become eligible for direct admission to a PhD program.

MINOR PATHWAYS

Kottakkal Farook College offers eight undergraduate programs under the FYUGP, each featuring a major discipline along with two minor groups. There are four minor pathways: Marketing, Quantitative Economics, Hospitality Business Administration, and Statistics. To achieve a minor pathway, students have to complete six courses within that pathway. Completing three courses from a minor group qualifies students for a half minor or a minor group.



