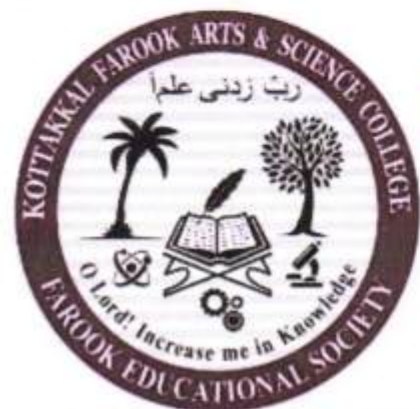

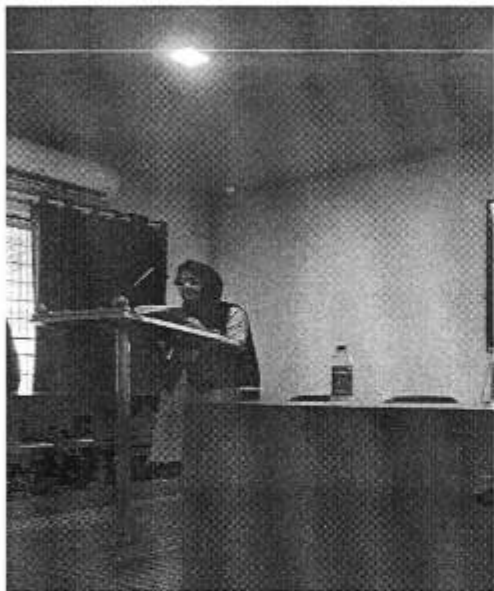

well-being. The speeches were insightful and demonstrated a deep understanding of the topic.

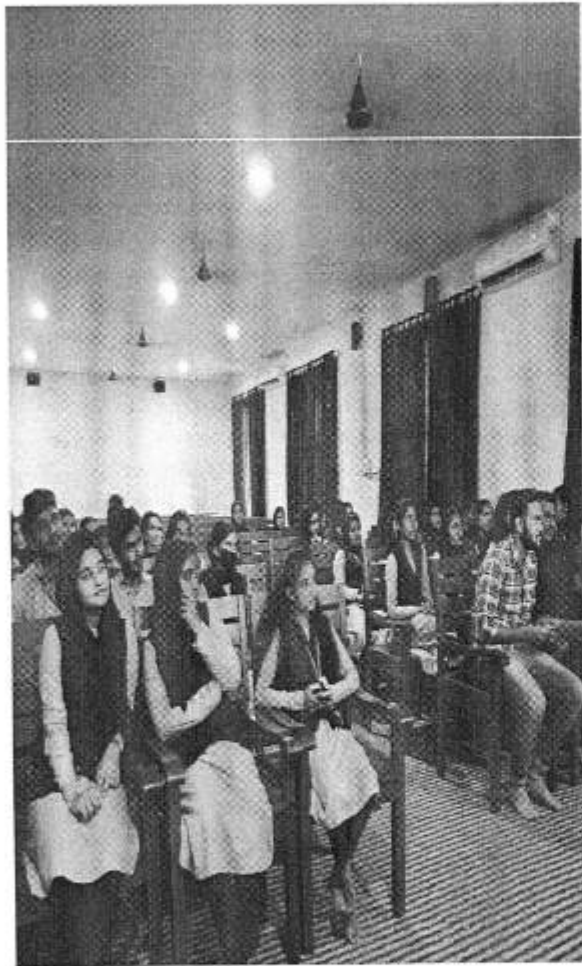
The judges for the event were:
