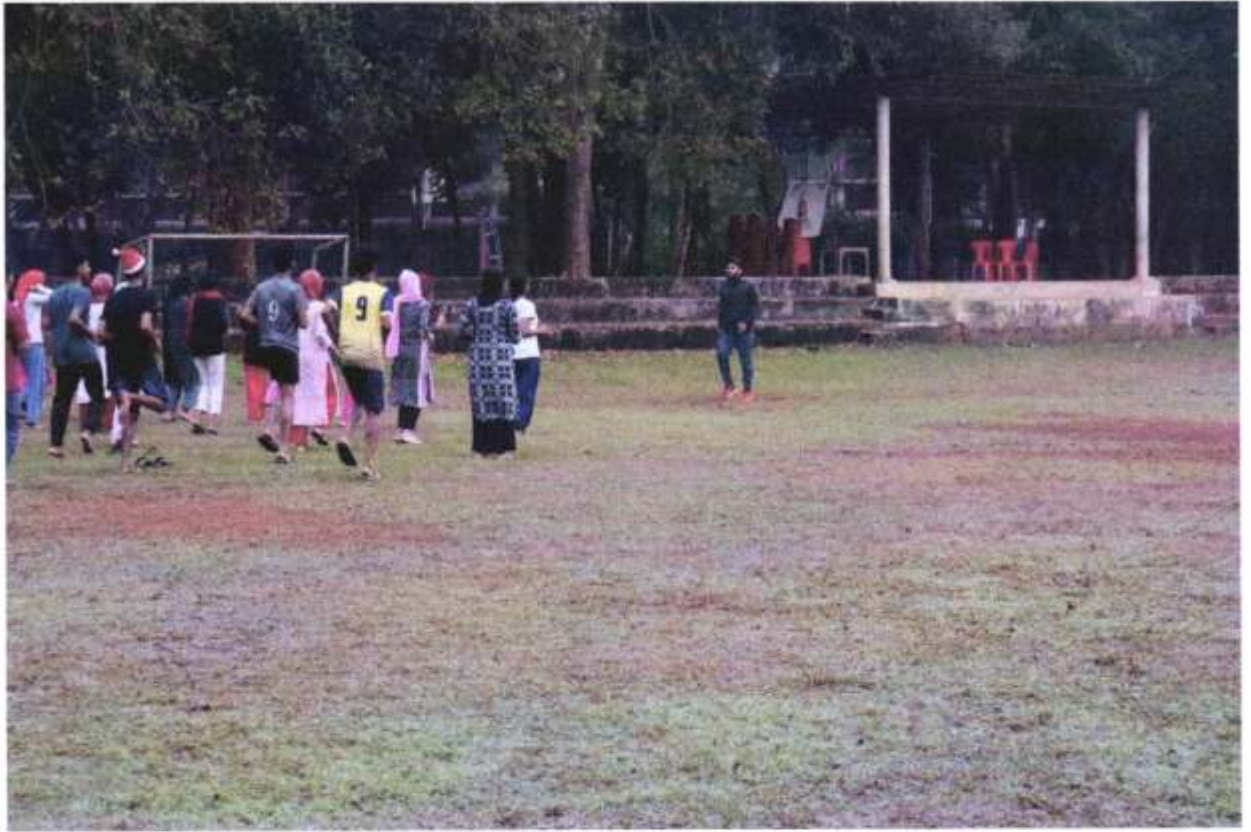

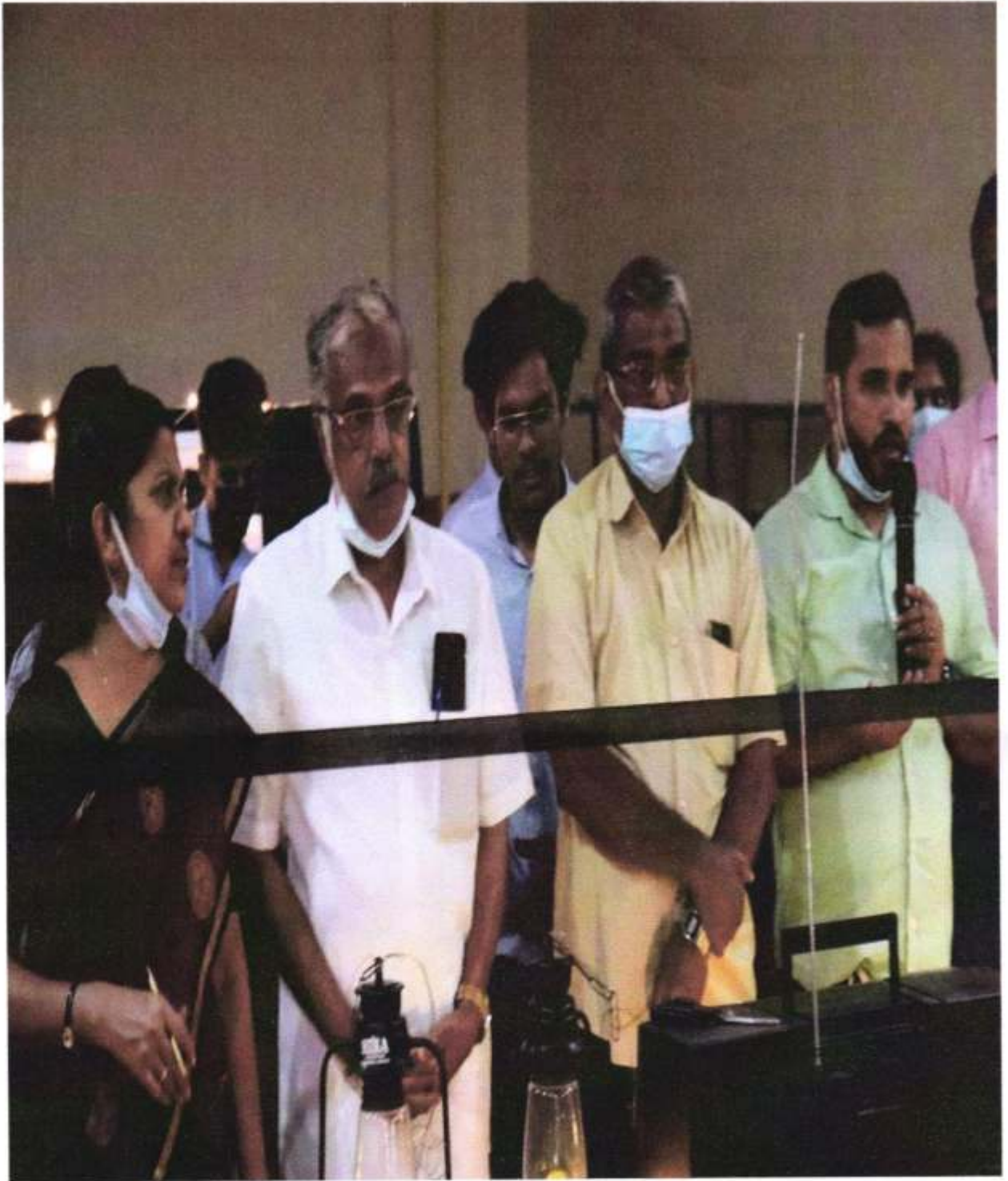


## Esperanza' 20

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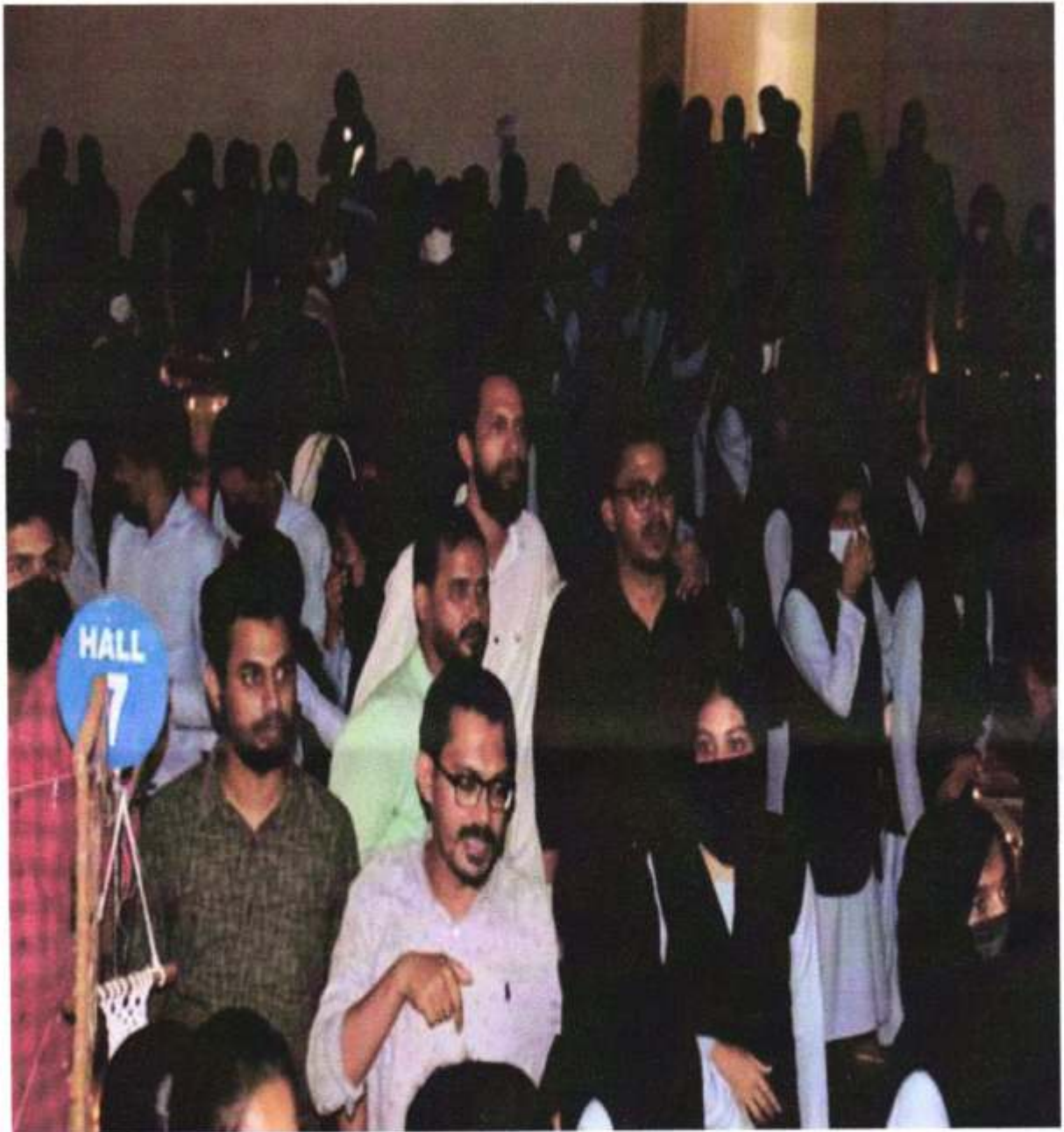

## Industrial Visit

### Sargalaya Craft Village Visit

On January 21, 2020, a group of 53 students from the ED (Entrepreneurship Development) Club embarked on an industrial visit to Sargalaya Craft Village in Iringal, Vadakara. This visit aimed to provide the students with insights into the traditional crafts of Kerala and to inspire entrepreneurial thinking by observing the operations of a successful craft village. The journey began early in the morning, with the students gathering at the school premises at 7:00 AM. They boarded the bus and departed at 7:30 AM. The trip was filled with anticipation and excitement as the students looked forward to exploring the craft village. After a scenic journey, the group arrived at Sargalaya Craft Village at approximately 10:00 AM. Upon arrival, the students were warmly welcomed by the staff of Sargalaya. They were given a brief introduction about the village, its history, and its mission to preserve and promote traditional crafts. The introductory session highlighted the importance of crafts in the local economy and the role of artisans in maintaining cultural heritage.


#### Tour of the Craft Village

The students were then divided into smaller groups and guided through various sections of the craft village. Each section showcased different crafts, including:
