### "SHUCHITHWA MISSION" CLEAN DRIVE

### INTRODUCTION

#### 4.Educating E-Banking Facilities Among Shop Owners in Tirunavaya Panchayath.

On 10th January 2019, a comprehensive extension activity was conducted involving 4thsemester commerce students to evaluate the usage of e-banking facilities among shop owners in Tirunavaya Panchayat. The primary objective was to assess the level of awareness, extent of adoption, and challenges faced by local businesses in utilizing e-banking services. Additionally, the activity aimed to educate shop owners on security-related matters to enhance the safe use of these services. The study focused on ten randomly selected shops within Tirunavaya Panchayat, employing structured interviews and questionnaires for data collection. The parameters assessed included awareness levels, frequency of e-banking usage, types of services employed, perceived benefits, and the challenges encountered by shop owners. Findings revealed that while a majority of shop owners were aware of e-banking facilities, their adoption in daily transactions was relatively low. The primary barriers identified were a lack of trust in the security of online transactions and inadequate knowledge of the various e-banking services available. The study also uncovered a need for further education on the benefits and security measures of e-banking to improve its usage.

Based on these findings, students provided targeted suggestions to shop owners, emphasizing the importance of secure practices and the potential advantages of e-banking in streamlining business operations. This activity not only benefited the shop owners but also enriched the students' understanding of real-world business challenges in the digital age.

Outcome: The extension activity resulted in increased awareness and understanding of ebanking services among shop owners in Tirunavaya Panchayat, leading to improved adoption and safer usage practices.


#### 1. Elocution Competition




#### 3.International Peace Day Commemoration
