



### NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME - UNIT NO 213 ANNUAL REPORT - 2019-2020




groups and selected the different areas for cleaning.

# 1. ECONOMIC RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS IN WARD 1, KOTTAKKAL MUNICIPALITY





#### 1. PHYSICS OF MUSIC

On June 20, 2019, the PG Department of Physics at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College organized a workshop titled "Physics of Music." The event took place at the college and was attended by 35 students from fifth semester and 20 residents from Ward 14, Parappur Panchavath. The workshop aimed to elucidate the physics principles underlying music, focusing on concepts such as sound waves, resonance, harmonics, and the Doppler effect Through a blend of theoretical instruction and hands-on activities, participants were able to build simple musical instruments and analyse acoustics in different environments. Demonstrations using tuning forks and glassware illustrated resonance, while string instruments and pipes were used to explain harmonics. The Doppler effect was visualized using moving sound sources. Participants actively engaged in building flutes and drums, reinforcing their understanding through practical application. The interactive sessions allowed them to ask questions and discuss concepts with instructors, fostering a deeper appreciation for the science behind music. #### 3. RENEWABLE ENERGY EXPLORATION WORKSHOP.

On 12th December 2019, the UG students of the PG Department of Physics at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College organized a "Renewable Energy Exploration Workshop." This workshop aimed to educate 42 students from first semester students and 35 residents from Ward 14, Parappur Panchayath on the principles and applications of renewable energy sources, such as solar, wind, and hydroelectric power. #### 5. THE PHYSICS OF EVERYDAY LIFE.

On 2<sup>rd</sup> march 2020, the PG Department of Physics at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College hosted a workshop titled "The Physics of Everyday Life." 

#### 5. Maths Quiz On Pi Day


