REPORT

INTRODUCTION

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College organized a comprehensive Faculty Development Programme (FDP) titled "Mastering Mastersoft ERP: Enhancing Academic Efficiency" from 1st June 2021 to 9th June 2021. Conducted online via the Zoom platform, this seven-day program aimed to equip faculty members with in-depth knowledge and practical skills in using Mastersoft ERP to streamline academic and administrative processes. A total of 55 (49 teaching and 6 teaching)members participated, making the FDP a significant initiative toward enhancing the college's academic efficiency.

The FDP commenced with an inaugural session at 10:00 AM on 1st June 2021. Mrs. T K Faheema, the IQAC Coordinator, delivered the welcome speech, followed by the presidential address by Mr. Mohammed Labeeb, Vice Principal of the college. The program was officially inaugurated by Prof. M Abdul Azeez, the Principal, who highlighted the importance of adopting modern ERP systems in educational institutions. Felicitations were offered by Mrs. Beenamol N S, Staff Secretary, Mr. Sreenath M, Head of the Department (HOD) of English, and Mr. Aboobacker Kutty Naha, HOD of Mathematics. The session concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Mujeeb T P, HOD of Commerce and Management.

Following the inaugural session, Mr. Rajesh Kumar, Senior ERP Consultant at Mastersoft Technologies, conducted a session titled "Introduction to Mastersoft ERP" from 11:30 AM to 01:00 PM. Mr. Kumar provided an overview of ERP systems, their significance in academic settings, and the various functionalities offered by Mastersoft ERP.

In the afternoon session from 02:00 PM to 03:30 PM, Ms. Priya Sharma, ERP Implementation Specialist at Mastersoft Technologies, presented on "Overview of ERP Modules for Academic Management." Ms. Sharma discussed the key modules of Mastersoft ERP and their applications in managing academic processes efficiently.

On 2nd June 2021, the first session from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM was on the "Student Information System (SIS)" by Mr. Arun Babu, Technical Lead at Mastersoft Technologies. Mr. Babu explained the functionalities of the SIS module, including student enrollment, record maintenance, and data management, emphasizing how these features can enhance administrative accuracy and efficiency.

In the afternoon, from 02:00 PM to 03:30 PM, Ms. Anjali Menon, ERP Project Manager at Mastersoft Technologies, conducted a session on "Course Management and Timetabling." She demonstrated the use of the ERP system in managing course schedules, faculty assignments, and classroom allocations, highlighting its role in optimizing timetable management and resource utilization.

The third day, 3rd June 2021, began with a session on "Attendance and Assessment Management" from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM, led by Dr. Vikram Desai, Academic Consultant at Mastersoft Technologies. Dr. Desai illustrated how the ERP system can automate attendance tracking and integrate it with assessment management to streamline academic reporting and evaluation processes.

From 02:00 PM to 03:30 PM, Ms. Shalini Roy, Senior Systems Analyst at Mastersoft Technologies, presented on the "Examination Module and Results Processing." She explained the capabilities of Mastersoft ERP in managing examination schedules, conducting online assessments, and processing results, ensuring accuracy and efficiency in academic evaluations.

On 4th June 2021, the session from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM focused on "Finance and Payroll Management," conducted by Mr. Suresh Pillai, Financial ERP Specialist at Mastersoft Technologies. From 02:00 PM to 03:30 PM, Mr. Naveen Jain, ICT Coordinator at Mastersoft Technologies, presented on "Communication and Collaboration Tools." Mr. Jain showcased various tools within the ERP system that facilitate communication and collaboration among faculty, staff, and students, enhancing institutional connectivity and information sharing.

On 7th June 2021, the session from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM focused on "Data Security and Privacy in ERP Systems," conducted by Mr. Ajay Thakur, Cybersecurity Expert at Mastersoft Technologies. Mr. Thakur emphasized the importance of data security, demonstrating how the ERP system ensures data privacy and protects against cyber threats.

In the afternoon from 02:00 PM to 03:30 PM, Ms. Ritu Aggarwal, Data Analyst at Mastersoft Technologies, discussed "Reporting and Analytics." Ms. Aggarwal illustrated the reporting capabilities of the ERP system, showing how to generate and analyze various academic and administrative reports to support data-driven decision-making.

The final day, 9th June 2021, began with a session on "Customization and User Interface" from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM by Mr. Deepak K., Software Developer at Mastersoft Technologies. Mr. Deepak demonstrated how to customize the ERP system to meet specific institutional needs, ensuring user-friendly interfaces and personalized workflows.

From 02:00 PM to 03:30 PM, Mr. Sanjay Patel, Lead Trainer at Mastersoft Technologies, conducted a "Hands-on Workshop and Q&A" session. Participants engaged in practical exercises to apply their learning, followed by a Q&A session where they could address specific queries and challenges.

The FDP concluded with a valedictory session from 03:30 PM to 04:00 PM. Participants shared their feedback and reflections, expressing appreciation for the comprehensive and practical nature of the program.


3. BASIC WRITING WORKSHOP AT NEARBY SCHOOLS TO ENHANCE STUDENTS WRITING SKILLS




3. WORKSHOP ON MAINTENANCE OF HOME APPLIANCES



1. Health Survey in The Village

The health survey conducted on October 25, 2021, in Parappur aimed to assess the health status, healthcare access, and health-related behaviours of the local population. The survey, designed with input from healthcare professionals and community members, included sections on demographics, health history, lifestyle factors, and healthcare utilization. A systematic sampling approach ensured diverse representation, and trained volunteers conducted face-to-face interviews. Key findings revealed a 60% prevalence of conditions such as fever, hypertension, diabetes, and high cholesterol. Health behaviours impacting diet, physical activity, sleep, and stress management were identified. Barriers to healthcare access included distance, cost, and service availability.

Outcomes: Developing health promotion campaigns for chronic disease management and maternal and child health, and implementing community-based health education workshops and support groups. Strategic interventions focus on policy advocacy, partnerships with healthcare providers and NGOs, and capacity building for healthcare providers and volunteers.


Study on women empowerment initiatives with special reference to Moochikkal ward, Valanchery




2. Workshop on "Basics of Research Methodology "


PUBLIC COVID AWARENESS & SURVEY


