"ENHANCING ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE THROUGH OUTCOME-BASED EDUCATION: STRATEGIES AND BEST PRACTICES"

REPORT

A 7-day Faculty Development Programme (FDP) titled "Enhancing Academic Excellence through Outcome-Based Education: Strategies and Best Practices" was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College from October 27, 2022, to November 2, 2022. The event aimed to equip faculty members with modern educational strategies and tools to improve academic excellence. A total of 58 members(49 teaching and 9 non teaching) members participated in the seven-day programme, which was structured into 15 sessions covering various topics pertinent to outcome-based education.

PROGRAMME SCHEDULE AND KEY HIGHLIGHTS:

Day 1: 27 October 2022

The programme commenced with an inauguration ceremony featuring several dignitaries. Mrs. T K Faheema, the IQAC Coordinator, delivered the welcome speech, followed by the presidential address by Mr. Muhammed Labeeb M, the Vice Principal. Prof. M. Abdul Azeez, the Principal, officially inaugurated the FDP. Felicitations were offered by Mr. Mujeeb T P and Mr. Sreenath M, while Mrs. Aswathi K T gave the vote of thanks.

Dr. Mahmood Shihab, Principal of Ansar Training College and HR Trainer, discussed the importance of effective human resource practices in educational institutions. He highlighted the need for robust HR policies, faculty development programs, and performance appraisal systems to enhance the efficiency and morale of academic staff.

Rafeek Kodiyengal, a social media influencer, focused on how social media can be effectively utilized for academic purposes. He demonstrated various social media tools and platforms educators can use to engage with students, share educational content, and promote academic events.

Day 2: 28 October 2022

Hancefa KT, a software administrator, emphasized technology integration in the educational process. He covered various educational technologies, including Learning Management Systems (LMS), online collaboration tools, and digital classrooms, and their role in enhancing teaching and learning experiences.

Dr. Ayesha Siddiqui, an educational psychologist, provided insights into student psychology. She discussed different psychological theories and their application in understanding student behavior, motivation, and learning styles, which can help educators tailor their teaching methods to meet students' needs.

Day 3: 29 October 2022

Dr. Praveen Kumar, an e-learning specialist, shared strategies for designing effective online courses. He highlighted the importance of interactive content, clear learning objectives, and regular assessments in creating engaging and effective online learning environments.

Mr. Muhammed Shafeeque U, an ASAP Trainer, discussed techniques for enhancing classroom communication. He emphasized the role of clear communication in the classroom, the use of interactive teaching methods, and the importance of feedback in the learning process.

Day 4: 30 October 2022

Dr. Ayyoob, a curriculum development specialist, spoke on innovative curriculum design. He discussed the principles of curriculum development, the importance of aligning curriculum with learning outcomes, and the need for continuous curriculum evaluation and improvement.

Dr. Meera Menon, an assessment expert, covered effective assessment strategies. She explained various assessment methods, including formative and summative assessments, and how they can be used to measure student learning and improve instructional practices.

Day 5: 31 October 2022

Dr. Muneer K, a soft skills trainer, highlighted the importance of building soft skills in students. He discussed various soft skills, such as communication, teamwork, and problem-solving, and provided strategies for incorporating soft skills training into the curriculum.

Dr. Munawar, a research methodology expert, presented on research methodologies in social sciences. He covered different research designs, data collection methods, and data analysis techniques, and provided practical tips for conducting rigorous and ethical research.

Day 6: 1 November 2022

Mr. Jitheesh T K, a data science specialist, discussed data-driven decision-making in education. He explained the importance of using data to inform educational decisions, demonstrated various data analysis tools, and provided examples of data-driven initiatives in education.

The diverse range of topics, from HR practices to advanced educational technologies, ensured that participants gained a holistic understanding of outcome-based education strategies. The feedback from the participating faculties highlighted the programmes success in enhancing their academic and professional competencies.

Action Taken Report (ATR) on Academic Administrative Audit (AAA)

Date of Audit: 09.01.2023

Surveillance of AAA Exercises at the Institution Observation:

The institution has effectively implemented AAA exercises with approval from authorities in line with accreditation bodies' criteria, such as NAAC and NBA. The mission is well-understood by staff, with aims and objectives aligned with the institution's mission. A systematic approach to quality assurance, governance principles, academic standards, transparent fund management, student and staff welfare, staff development, teaching and learning environment, and physical environment are noted.

Action Taken:

- Quality Assurance: A workshop was conducted to further educate staff on the institution's quality assurance definitions and principles.
- Governance: Policies were made accessible online, and additional training on governance principles was provided.
- Academic Standards: Regular monitoring and improvements were maintained with more frequent internal assessments and external peer reviews.
- Transparency in Fund Management: Enhanced transparency through periodic internal and external audits; the budget was restructured for better alignment with long-term goals.
- Staff Development: Introduced more frequent performance appraisals with clear feedback mechanisms.
- Learning Environment: Regular maintenance checks were initiated to ensure a conducive learning environment, with upgrades to library and lab facilitie.

2. Best Practices Followed in the Organization Observation:

Commendable practices such as maintaining course diaries/logbooks, encouraging AAA among staff and students, peer reviews, maintaining high educational standards, sustainable campus ecosystem, and effective waste management.

Action Taken:

- Course Diaries/Logbooks: A centralized digital system was introduced for easier access and updating of course-related documents.
- Peer Reviews: Continued to implement peer reviews with an added focus on integrating external academic inputs.
- Campus Ecosystem: Enhanced the biodiversity efforts with additional planting drives and expanded the solid waste management program

3. Recommendations for Improving the AAA Activities Recommendation 1:

Development of policies like 'Green Campus and Environment Policy,' 'Sanitation and Hygiene Policy,' 'Water Conservation Policy,' 'Waste Management Policy,' 'Energy Policy,' and 'Purchase Policy.'



Action Taken:

- Drafted and approved the 'Green Campus and Environment Policy' and 'Water Conservation Policy.'
- Collaborated with local governmental and non-governmental organizations for policy implementation and awareness programs.
- Ongoing work on other policies with planned roll-out within the next academic year.

Recommendation 2:

Installation of suggestion boxes and first aid boxes in different buildings.

Action Taken

- Suggestion boxes were installed in key locations across the campus.
- First aid boxes were placed in all major buildings, with periodic checks for supplies.

Recommendation 3:

Make helpline numbers for waste collection available on campus.

Action Taken:

 Established a waste management helpline service and circulated the numbers across campus.

Recommendation 4:

Promote an eco-friendly culture and minimize the use of plastics, nonbiodegradable materials, and exploitation of natural resources.

Action Taken:

- Launched a 'Green Campus Initiative' campaign to reduce plastic usage and raise environmental awareness.
- Regular workshops and seminars are conducted to educate students and staff on sustainability.

Recommendation 5:

Operate battery cars or autos for internal mobility on campus.

Introduction

Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College (KFASC) has consistently leveraged technology to enhance its educational and administrative processes, aligning with its e-governance policy. This report provides a comprehensive overview of the advancements in the college's technological infrastructure and resources, including hardware updates, software management, internet reliability, network security, and user support. It also outlines the future plans for continued growth and development in these areas.

1. Hardware Updates

KFASC has maintained a detailed inventory of its hardware devices, ensuring that they are upto-date, compatible with new software, and functioning optimally. The following steps were taken:

- Inventory Management: A systematic assessment of hardware performance, age, and compatibility was conducted to prioritize updates.
- Budget Allocation: Funds were allocated strategically to update hardware based on current needs and technological trends.
- Vendor Relationships: Strong relationships with vendors were maintained to ensure access to the latest products and support services.
- Implementation: Updates were carried out during off-peak hours to minimize disruption, with thorough testing conducted beforehand.
- Training and Support: Staff received training on new hardware, with ongoing support
 provided to address any issues.

3. Internet Bandwidth and Reliability

The college has made significant strides in enhancing internet bandwidth and reliability to support both students and staff:

- Bandwidth Capacity: The college provides internet connectivity through multiple ISPs, including BSNL NME (40 Mbps), Kerala Vision (50 Mbps), and Airtel Xtream (300 Mbps), BSNL NME (30 Mbps) ensuring fast and reliable internet access across campus.
- Wi-Fi Accessibility: Wi-Fi is available for all staff and students, with a 300 Mbps speed Airtel Xtream connection, providing robust connectivity for academic and administrative activities.
- Redundancy Measures: Failover mechanisms and switches between connections were implemented to ensure uninterrupted internet access.
- Network Monitoring: Regular monitoring and maintenance were carried out to address potential issues proactively.

4. Network Security

KFASC has taken extensive measures to ensure network security and availability:

- Firewall and Proxy Servers: IP Fire and PF Sense Firewall Control were employed to manage unauthorized access, with proxy servers providing additional security.
- Fixed Public IPs: These were utilized for accessing internal server applications from outside the campus.
- High-End Networking Devices: These devices ensured simultaneous access to servers for all users, with a campus network backbone of 1 Gbps.
- Comprehensive Coverage: Optical fibres were installed across 100% of the campus to provide consistent and high-speed connectivity.

5. User Support and Accessibility

To support the college community, KFASC has established robust user support services:

- Help Desks and Technical Support: Available through a portal request system, ensuring that students and staff receive timely assistance.
- Training Programs: Regular training sessions were conducted to familiarize users with new systems and technologies.
- IT Accessibility: All IT facilities are accessible to staff and students through secure
 user IDs and passwords.

6. Comprehensive Overview of Technological Resources

KFASC boasts a wide range of technological resources to support its educational mission:


AIDS DAY CELEBRATION


5. A Seminar on "The Impact of Magical Realism in Latin American Literature"




1. Workshop on "Fiscal Policies and Their Impact on the Indian Economy"




1.Justicia


2. PRO-ERA 2.0

1.Impact of Digital Payment Systems for Consumers in Ward 1, Kottakkal Municipality

The extension activity conducted on JUNE 14, 2022, by 5th semester economics students from Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College provided insightful data on the impact of digital payment systems among consumers in Ward 1 of Kottakkal Municipality. The study, which combined quantitative surveys of 150 households and qualitative interviews with 20 participants including local shop owners, highlighted high awareness (95%) and substantial usage (78%) of digital payments, with 60% of users engaging in digital transactions at least weekly. The primary benefits identified were convenience (85%), time-saving (70%), and enhanced security (65%), although significant challenges such as technical issues (40%), lack of knowledge (30%), and limited vendor acceptance were also noted. The study further revealed that digital payments influenced consumer behavior, with 55% of users reporting an increase in spending and 50% indicating improved financial management. Based on these findings, the report recommends educational programs to enhance consumer and vendor knowledge, the establishment of a local helpline to address technical issues, incentives for vendors to increase digital payment acceptance, and improvements in network infrastructure to ensure reliability. The activity underscored the positive impact of digital payments on financial inclusion and economic efficiency while recognizing the need for addressing existing challenges to further boost adoption.



Impact of Digital Payment Systems for Consumers in Ward

Outcome: This comprehensive analysis not only sheds light on the current state of digital payment systems in the local community but also provides actionable recommendations for enhancing their efficiency and adoption, thereby contributing to a more inclusive and economically efficient society. The study was made possible through the cooperation of Ward 1 residents and the dedicated efforts of the faculty and students of the Department of Economics, to whom we extend our heartfelt gratitude.

2. Analysis of Healthcare Issues in Ward 1, Kottakkal Municipality

On July 25, 2022, the Department of Economics at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College conducted an extension activity to analyze healthcare issues in Ward 1, Kottakkal Municipality, focusing on public health policies and healthcare financing. This activity, led by third semester economics students, aimed to evaluate the effectiveness of public health policies, the challenges of healthcare financing, and the economic impact on households. The study employed a mixedmethods approach, including surveys of 200 households, interviews with 30 healthcare providers and community leaders, and two focus group discussions to gather diverse perspectives. The findings revealed that 80% of respondents were aware of public health policies, yet only 40% felt they were adequately implemented. Out-of-pocket healthcare expenses were a significant burden for 70% of households, with only 30% having health insurance. Additionally, while 65% of respondents lived within 5 km of a healthcare facility, 45% reported issues with service quality, such as long wait times and inadequate facilities. Economically, households spent 10-15% of their monthly income on healthcare, with 40% resorting to borrowing money or selling assets to cover costs. The activity's outcomes included raising awareness about the economic dimensions of healthcare policies and providing policy recommendations. These recommendations emphasized the need for enhanced awareness programs about health insurance, improved implementation of public health policies, targeted financial support for vulnerable households, and infrastructure development to improve service quality.



Analysis of Healthcare Issues in Ward 1, Kottakkal Municipality

Outcome: The activity also highlighted the need for further research on healthcare financing and policy effectiveness at the local level. The extension activity offered valuable insights into the healthcare challenges in Ward 1, underscoring the necessity of addressing economic burdens and policy implementation issues to achieve better health outcomes and financial stability for the local community. 3. Agricultural Economic Workshop

Many farmers expressed intentions to adopt sustainable farming practices introduced during the workshop, recognizing their potential for long-term economic benefits. Additionally, farmers gained valuable skills in budgeting, saving, and investment, which they planned to apply to enhance their financial stability. Improved market strategies were also a key outcome, as farmers were provided with information and techniques to better access and navigate local and regional markets, allowing them to sell their produce at more competitive prices. The workshop fostered a strong sense of community among participants, who appreciated the opportunity to share experiences and learn from each other, promoting ongoing collaboration and support. Based on participant feedback, follow-up sessions and continuous support initiatives were planned to ensure the ongoing application of the knowledge and skills gained during the workshop.

On January 15, 2023, the Department of Economics at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College organized a career guidance workshop for residents of Ward 1, Kottakkal Municipality, conducted by 4th semester economics students under faculty supervision. The workshop aimed to provide young individuals with career guidance, helping them make informed decisions about their future. The workshop featured presentations by experts in various fields, interactive sessions for personalized advice, distribution of resource materials, and follow-up support for career counseling. Key findings indicated that while many participants aspired to traditional careers in engineering, medicine, and government services, awareness of emerging fields like data science and renewable energy was limited. Participants sought more information on educational qualifications for competitive exams such as NEET, JEE, and UPSC, and showed a strong interest in developing both soft and technical skills. The workshop highlighted local job opportunities in healthcare, education, and small-scale industries, as well as global career trends in IT, healthcare, and environmental sciences. The importance of higher education and vocational training was emphasized, along with strategies for preparing for competitive exams and job interviews.

The workshop was well-received, with participants appreciating the valuable information and support provided. Outcomes included increased awareness of career options, greater motivation and confidence to pursue career goals, and enhanced support from the college for the local community.

5. Financial Inclusion Workshop in Ward 1, Kottakkal Municipality

The financial inclusion workshop conducted on February 22, 2023, by 2nd semester economics students from the Department of Economics at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College aimed to enhance financial literacy among residents of Ward 1, Kottakkal Municipality. The workshop sought to educate participants on the importance of financial inclusion, introduce them to various financial services, and guide them in managing bank accounts, using digital payment systems, and accessing credit and insurance services. Preceding the workshop, surveys and focus group discussions with 100 households provided insights into the residents' financial literacy and access to services. Presentations by experts, interactive sessions, practical demonstrations, and distribution of informational materials formed the core structure of the workshop. Key findings highlighted that while 70% of participants were aware of banking services, only 40% were familiar with digital financial tools. Bank account ownership stood at 60%, but there was low usage of credit (25%) and insurance services (20%). Barriers to financial inclusion included a lack of knowledge and trust in digital tools (50%) and cumbersome documentation requirements (30%). The workshop's impact was significant, improving participants' awareness, confidence in using digital financial tools, and financial management skills. It also promoted economic stability and empowerment, particularly among marginalized groups. Overall, the workshop was well-received, fostering community engagement and collaboration with local financial institutions.




5: HUMAN RIGHTS AWARNESS CAMPAIGN


1. Community Based Research Project by PG Department of Physics

The PG Department of Physics at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College organized a Community Based Research project on June 25, 2022, in Ward 14, Parappur Panchayath, engaging 35 students and 20 local residents to address environmental challenges. The project aimed to investigate water quality, measure air pollution, assess energy usage patterns, and engage the community in scientific research. Students collected and tested water samples for contaminants, monitored air quality with portable sensors, conducted energy usage surveys, and held interactive workshops to educate residents on sustainable practices. The findings revealed high bacterial contamination in water sources, elevated PM2.5 levels indicating poor air quality, and excessive energy usage in some households. Recommendations included improved sanitation, better air quality management, and adoption of energy-efficient practices. The project successfully enhanced community awareness about environmental issues and established a collaborative framework for future research initiatives.

Outcome: Residents raised concerns about the accuracy of water testing methods, health implications of air pollution, and practical ways to reduce energy consumption. This initiative demonstrated the potential of community-based research in providing valuable data and empowering local communities to take proactive steps towards sustainability.

5. Report on Science Equipment Donation by PG Department of Physics

2. REPORT ON PUBLIC OPINION SURVEY ON VARIOUS LOCAL ISSUES

The Mathematics Department of Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College conducted a public opinion survey in the 13th ward of Parappur Panchayath to understand local issues, engage students in data collection, and provide insights for local authorities. The survey covered public safety, education, infrastructure, healthcare, environmental concerns, community services, economic opportunities, public involvement, utilities, and future outlook. Results indicated a general sense of safety, moderate satisfaction with education, mixed reviews on infrastructure, positive views on healthcare accessibility, high concern for environmental issues, good but improvable community services, mixed perceptions of job opportunities, moderate community engagement, high satisfaction with utilities, and optimism about future development. Specific findings showed that 70% felt somewhat or very safe, 60% were satisfied with local education, and 35% rated infrastructure as fair. Healthcare was deemed accessible and effective by 45%, while 75% were concerned or very concerned about environmental issues. Community services were rated good by 50%, and utilities satisfied 65% of respondents. Job opportunities had mixed feedback, with 35% agreeing on adequacy. Community engagement was moderate, with 40% involved or very involved. Optimism about future development was prevalent, with 55% optimistic.

Outcome: The survey provided actionable insights for local authorities and practical experience for students, highlighting strengths and areas for improvement to enhance residents' quality of life.


3. Report on Tutoring Mathematics Revision Classes for SSLC students
