2. Review of previous year's Actions and outcomes: The Convenor presented a review of the actions and measures taken in the previous -




academic year. It was noted that there were no reported cases of ragging, indicating the effectiveness of the cell's initiatives.

- * Regularly monitor canteen premises, parking lot, and student centre.
- * Establish a 24x7 helpline number for students to report any incidents of ragging
- * Display anti-ragging posters and banners at prominent locations within the campus
- * Collaborate with local law enforcement to ensure swift action in case of any ragging incidents

- * The cell decided to meet to review the progress and address any emerging issues whenever required
- * The principal emphasized the importance of creating safe and conducive environment for all students.

Patrol Areas Covered:-

Observations:-

- * 1. Academic blocks:- No incidents of Ragging were reported; students were attending classes.
- * Student Hostels:- A minor altercation involving Senior and junior students was reported. No physical harm occurred.
- * Cafeteria:- Peaceful, students were engaged in social activities.
- * Library:- Quiet and orderly. No ragging incidents reported.
- * Recreation Areas:- Active student engagement with no reports of ragging.

Action taken:-

Conducted Counseling sessions for students involved.

- 2 Hostel Area:- Interaction with hostel warden revealed no complaints of ragging from the residents
- * Random room checks showed no signs of ragging activities
- 3 Canteen:-
The atmosphere were peaceful, with student having their meals and socializing without any issues.
- 4 Library:-
The environment was quiet and conducive to studying. No ragging incidents were reported by the library staff.
- 5 Sports Complex:-
Students were actively engaged in sports activities. Coaches confirmed no ragging incidents
- 6 Common Areas:-
Patrolling in courtyards and student centers showed a friendly and respectful interaction among students. No signs of ragging were found

Action taken:-

- 1 Awareness programmes:-
- * Distributed pamphlets on anti-ragging measures and helpline numbers to students in common areas.
- * Scheduled anti-ragging seminars to be conducted next week by an external expert to reinforce the anti-ragging message.
- Increased vigilance:-
Instructed the hostel warden and security staff



to be extra vigilant during late hours.


- * Decided to install additional CCTV cameras in hostel corridors and Common areas for better monitoring

3 Student Support = -

- * Set up a Confidential drop box in the library for students to report any ragging incidents anonymously.
- * ~~Rein~~ Reinforced the availability of the 24/7 helpline for reporting ragging incidents.

4 Coordination with Authorities = -

- * Conducted local law enforcement to ensure their cooperation in case of any reported ragging incidents.
- * Arranged a meeting with student representatives to discuss their concerns and suggestions regarding Campus safety.
- * Increased vigilance and night-time patrols in hostel areas.
- * Organized an anti-ragging awareness seminar for all students
- * Displayed anti-ragging posters and helpline numbers in prominent locations.




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

3. Postal Report:


- * Regular patrols were conducted throughout the year, focusing on hostels, common areas, and secluded spots.

- * Develop a more interactive orientation programme with role-playing activities to demonstrate the negative effects of ragging.
- * Enhance collaboration with local law enforcement to include more frequent campus visits.
- * Introduce anonymous feedback mechanism for students to report any concerns without fear or retribution.



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
