



POLICY & REGULATIONS ANTI-RAGGING CELL

Policy and Regulations:

Prohibition of Ragging:

- 1. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the campus and outside.
- 2. Any student found indulging in ragging will be subject to strict disciplinary action including suspension, expulsion, or legal proceedings.

Measures for Prevention:

- 1. **Awareness Programs:** Conduct regular awareness programs, workshops, and seminars to educate students about the consequences of ragging.
- 2. Mentorship: Assign senior students as mentors to freshers to provide guidance and support.
- 3. Counseling: Provide counseling services to both victims and perpetrators of ragging.

Reporting Mechanism:

- 1. **Helpline:** Establish a 24/7 helpline number for students to report ragging incidents.
- 2. **Complaint Box:** Set up complaint boxes at accessible locations on campus for anonymous reporting.
- 3. **Online Reporting:** Provide an online platform for students to lodge complaints.

Investigation and Action:

- 1. **Prompt Action:** The Anti-Ragging Squad shall conduct prompt and thorough investigations into reported incidents.
- 2. **Disciplinary Measures:** The Anti-Ragging Committee shall review the recommendations of the Squad and take appropriate disciplinary action.
- 3. Support to Victims: Ensure victims receive necessary medical and psychological support.

Monitoring and Evaluation:

- 1. **Regular Meetings:** Conduct regular meetings of the Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad to review the status and effectiveness of anti-ragging measures.
- 2. **Surveillance:** Install CCTV cameras in strategic locations to monitor and deter ragging activities.
- 3. **Feedback:** Collect feedback from students to continually improve anti-ragging measures.
