- Encourage critical thinking and problem-solving exercises in the coursework.

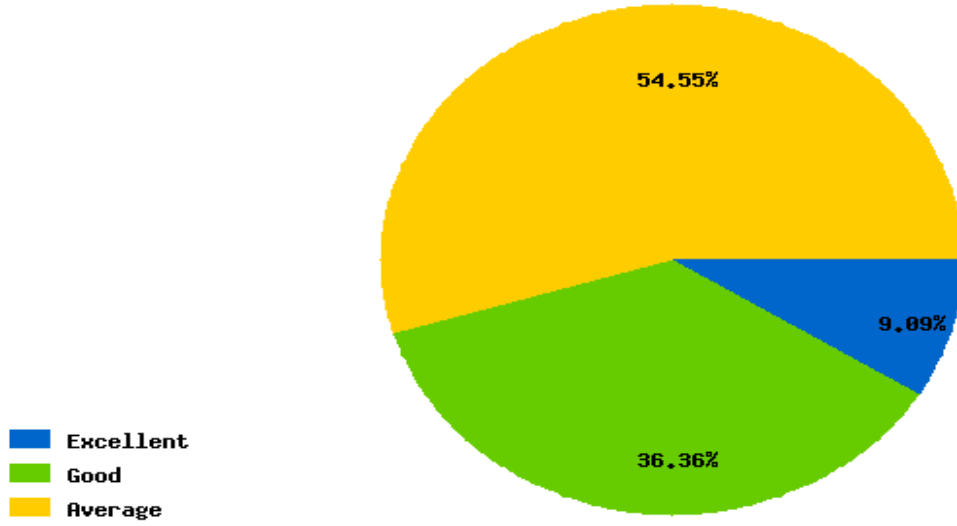
5. Promote Teamwork and Collaboration:

6. Increase Adaptability:

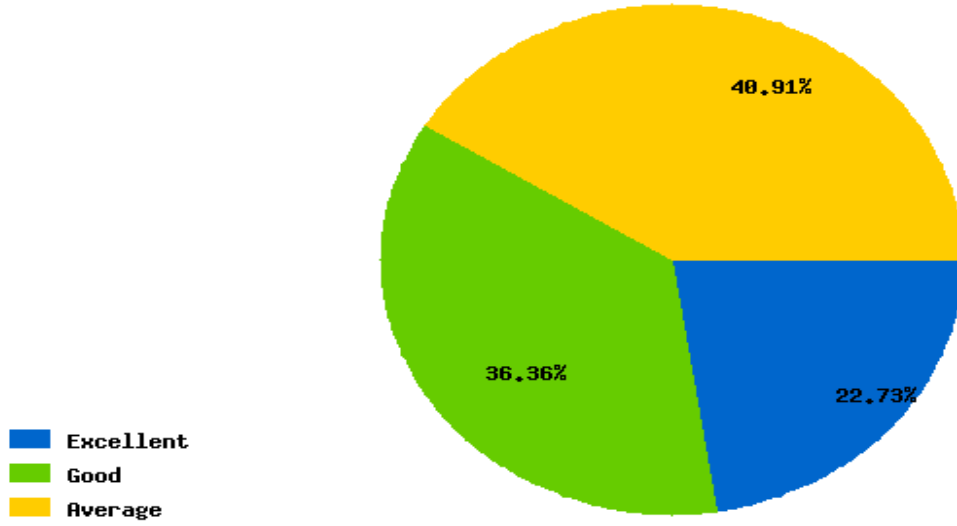
- Prepare students to adapt to changes and new challenges in the workplace.

1. Overall Performance (Total responses: 22)



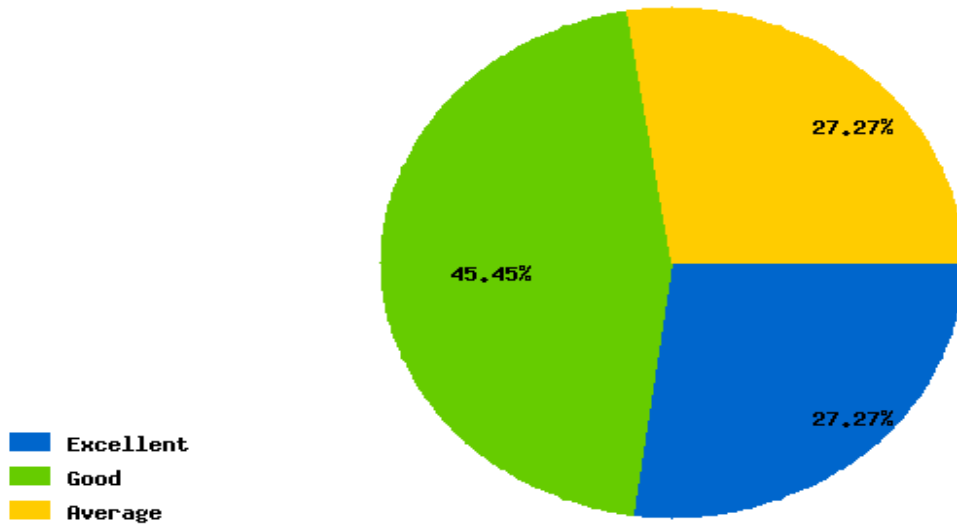

2. Professional Knowledge and Skills (Total responses: 22)



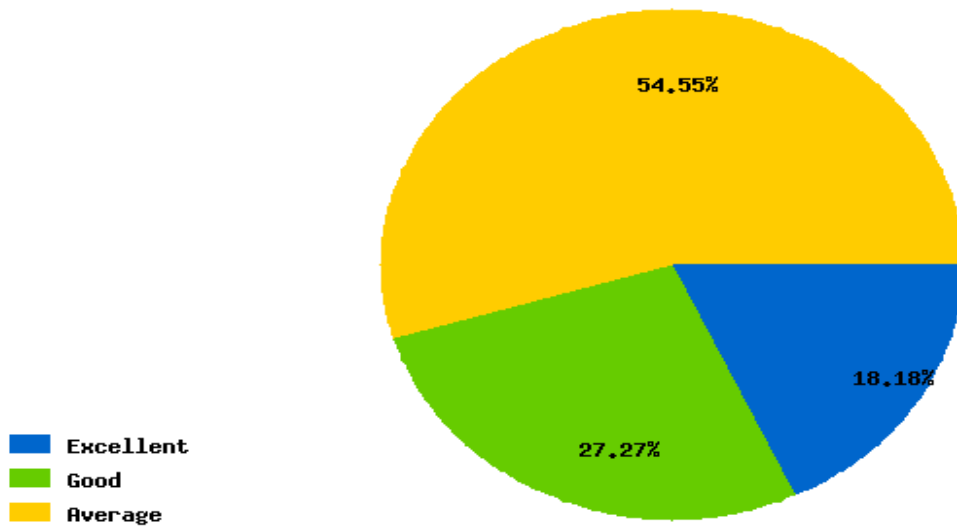

3. Communication Skills (Total responses: 22)



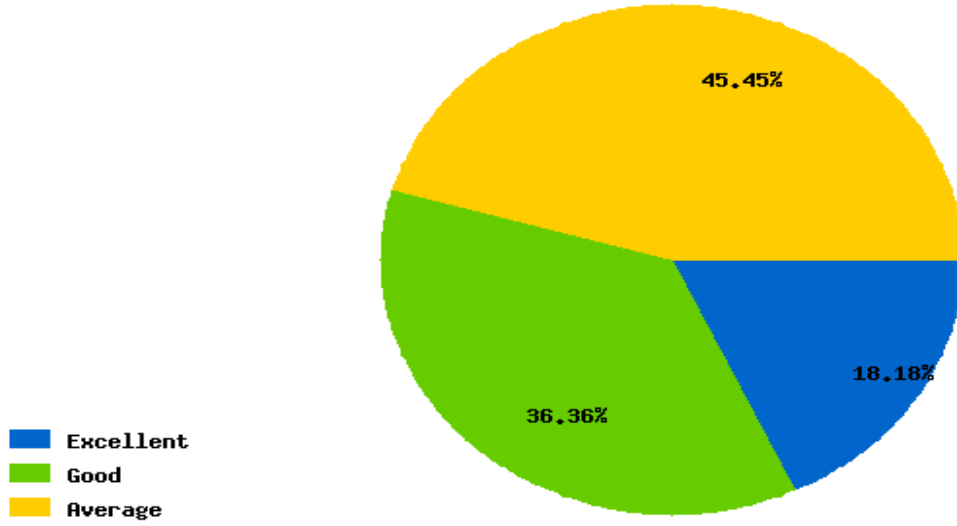

4. Problem-Solving Abilities (Total responses: 22)



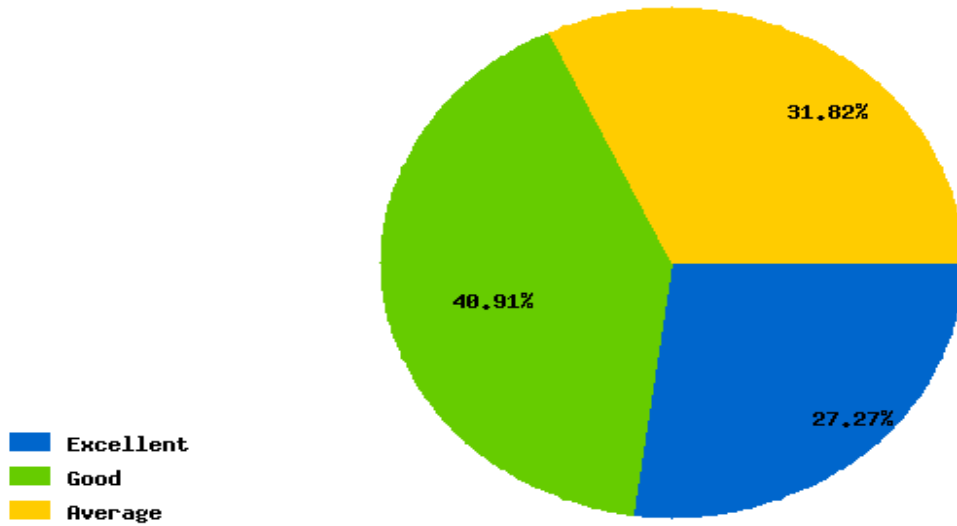
